- Can I also thank Ward Councillor Geoff Summers who is retiring this
 year after many years of service to our Ward also the money he has
 allocated to us from his official fund. The most recent sum has
 purchased a new recycled bench that will be dedicated to Councillor
 Summers.
- A thank you also to **Clir Bonney's** attendance and advice at our meetings has been most welcome.
- Our Parish Clerk Julie Haycraft has again undergone and passed several training courses and qualifications to not only help herself do the work but has put the PC on track in these increasingly complicated times where we need to have policies for nearly everything we do.
- As she is **also Normanby PC's clerk** it ensuring clear communications between the two Councils and an added bonus any training costs are split between the two PC's.

- Chased West Lindsey reference the ongoing saga of pot holes and fly tipping.
- Reviewed and commented on the various planning applications.
- Organised litter picks, the latest one was only yesterday where members of both villages collected 15 bags of rubbish.
- **Kept up to date all our policies** both internal for example finance, bullying and harassment and external, for example using volunteers, not simple in these Health and Safety / Litigious days.
- Agreed jointly with NPC the grass cutting contract for our joint assets i.e. the Community Park and the cemetery.
- Maintenance work in the cemetery where members of both PC's cut back the middle hedge and lifted the branches on the Cherry Trees.
- The **rabbit damage** issue seems to have subsided although it will re occur I am sure.
- Kept updating our web site where all the Parish Council agendas / minutes are placed and also our Face Book page.
- Memners from the two Parish Councils have sat on and participated in the Community Park Committee meetings.
- OPC **maintain a defibrillator** on the end of Richard Harrison's electrical workshop on Owmby Cliff Road.
