General Comments	Dangerous very large branch has snapped off from large tree to the left of the field entrance, just before the green bench at Highgate Lane end. It appears to have stuck in the ground at one end, but the other is wedge on a high branch. Recommend: Get tree surgeon to sort out as a matter of urgency and also ask him about the large branch over the Highgate Lane entrance. Substancial fence post with some barbed wire wrapped around it in orchard is now visible after vegetation has died back. Still need CPC meeting to discuss issues in more detail and allocate resources. Ian McCleod (Mole catcher) did a good job with mole hills less evident in main field. Some activity noted in Orchard area. Mound of earth in orchard still needs moving asap. Bird strips stil need fitting to 2 bay swing set.
